Introduction

The school has implemented procedures necessary to ensure the safety of all personnel in event of an emergency situation.

The Aim of the Policy is:

- To ensure that a procedure is in place that can be easily followed in the event of a serious and imminent threat or danger to students, staff and visitors to Carisbrooke High School

The Policy

The school will:

- Enable safe and secure evacuations of all or part of the buildings on site.
- Ensure that students and staff engaged on school business follow agreed procedures in the event of a threat, danger or accident both on and off site.
- Ensure an 'on call' rota of Leadership Team members is in place to cover all eventualities.
